



Is there a project you'd like to complete in your neighborhood?

Vancouver Watersheds Alliance has Neighborhood Grant funding available now! Grants are up to **\$2,000**, for projects with a community environmental benefit.

Potential projects include:

- Dog waste stations
- Friends of Trees neighborhood plantings
- Invasive tree removal
- Storm drain or street murals
- Nature play areas
- Cigarette receptacles
- and more...

The Process

- 1) Have an idea! Minimum guidelines include:
 - Project is connected to a City of Vancouver Neighborhood Association
 - Project benefits larger audience/general public
 - Group is able to fulfill the match requirement**
- 2) Have your project idea approved by your Neighborhood Association (NA)
- 3) Complete the Grant Application packet
- 4) Grant review. If approved, contract is written, signed, and funds awarded
- 5) Grantees submit final report on the project.

**All grants require equal matching funds in the form of cash or in-kind donations, including volunteer hours.
